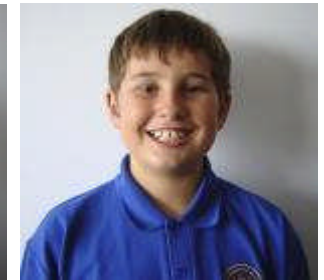

Deaf Olympics

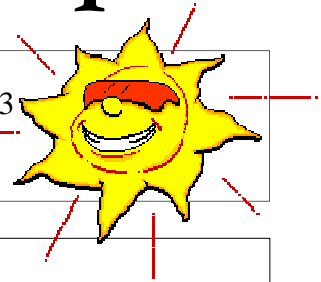

The new prefects have already started doing a good job.

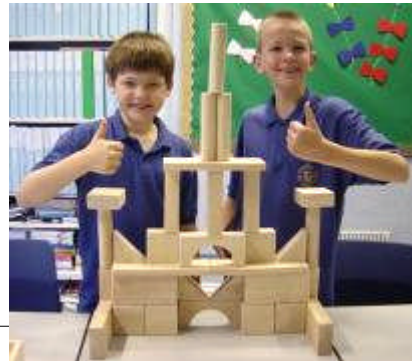
Bartek, Shanal, Sarah and Marielle have been helping us all and they have
