Hair & Nails

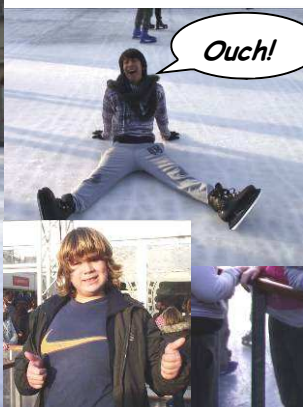
