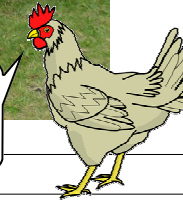


Chickens

Christmas Cards

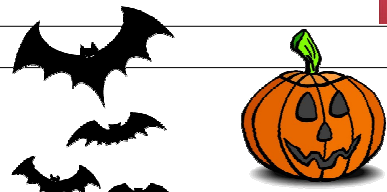


Christmas cards go on sale next week. A picture of the winning card will be in next weeks newspaper.

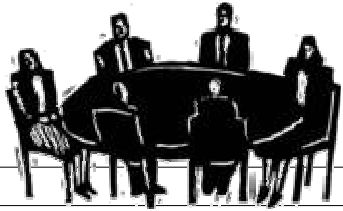
