Mrs Grant went to City College and saw Lewis on his stall for his enterprise work. There were fantastic bug nests. Well done, Lewis!

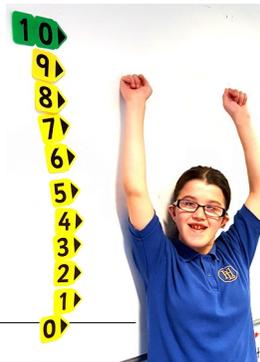


Lewis also made this lovely cake at college and gave it to Ben for his birthday. We all got some and it was very tasty!



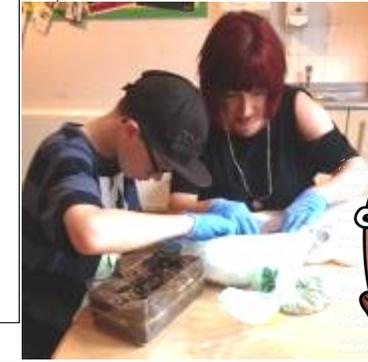
## Tayah Counting
